

In 1888, Balto was recruited by Fridtjof Nansen for Nansen's Trans-Greenland Expedition. Balto participated in the first recorded crossing of the interior of Greenland, together with Nansen and four other expedition members.

#### Language Lesson - hosted by John Olsen - THANK YOU John ©

Today's language lesson focused on items at a farm, such as: farmer (bonde), produce (grøde), carrot (gulrot), potatoes (poteter), vegetables (grønnsaker), fruit (frukt), apples (epler), animals (dyr), & herder (gjeter).

#### Today's program "Kulning" or Calling the Cows Home - hosted by Terry Lord & Phil Knudsen

- Kulning / Kulokk or herding calls is a domestic <u>Scandinavian</u> music form, often used to call livestock (cows, goats, etc.) down from high mountain pastures where they have been grazing during the day. <u>Pronounced 'coolning,' kulning</u> is a contraction of the words 'Kuh' (cow) and 'lock' (to call or coax). Kulokk is said to be the oldest musical tradition in Norway, dating back to at least the Middle Ages. There are many samples in the Oslo and Valdres Folk Music Archives. Even Norwegian composer <u>Edvard Grieg</u> based a few of his classical music compositions for piano and for orchestra on kulokkers that he had heard. Who knew?
- Some of the singing is quite beautiful and relaxing. You can hear Kulning songs on utube Jonna Jinton is one of my favorites. Some ancient calls can also be heard which has a little sharper tone.
