Norwegian egg coffee

I. Ingredients

5 Tbsp. coffee (medium grind works best)

1 egg

II. Instructions

Beat egg in a small bowl with a fork. Add coffee grounds and mix until you have a sludge.

Bring 7 cups of water to a boil in a large coffee pot or saucepan. Add coffee/egg mixture. Continue boiling until the foam disappears – about 3 minutes. Remove from heat.

Add 1 cup of cold water to the coffee pot.

This will help settle the grounds.

Pour coffee through a strainer to catch any loose grounds. Serve.

Teresa covered the Norwegian World Heritage Sites, such as: 1) Urnes Stave Church dating back to the 12th century is the oldest Viking church still standing in its original location; 2) Bryggen in Bergen known for its colorful 12th century wooden buildings and remains one of the most significant trading ports; 3) Roros – a beautiful 17th century copper mining town; 4) Rock Art of Alta dating back over 7,000 years and provides a glimpse into the lives of early hunter-gatherer societies in the Arctic; 5) Vega Archipelago in the Helgeland region beholds 6,500 islands, inlets & reefs; 6) Struve Geodetic Arc determines the exact size & shape of the planet; 7) West Norwegian Fjords with their crystal clear waters, towering cliffs, cascading waterfalls and picturesque landscapes; 8) and finally the Rjukan-Notodden Industrial hydroelectric power plant. wow!
